

The follow up actions taken on the basis of the suggestions and opinions of Teachers, Students and Alumni considering priority and feasibility are mentioned below:

Suggestions/Opinions of Stakeholders	Follow up Action Taken
Post Graduate Programmes not available in all subjects.	Perspective plan prepared to introduce Post Graduate Programme in all subjects.
Needs more facilities for pure drinking water in the college campus.	A centrally supplied RO filtered pure running drinking water facility provided.
Need more digital class room	Proposed to enhance number of digital classrooms in phase manner.
More equipments, chemicals and specimens to do laboratory practical required.	All laboratories have been facilitated with required chemicals, specimens and equipments regularly.
The admission and other fee of science students are not free like arts students, so steps should be taken for Govt. Provincialisation of Science Stream.	Due to constant effort of the college, Govt. of Assam made Provincialisation of Science Stream and the students availed the Free ship in admission and other Govt. facilities.
More cash counters and man-power required in the office of the college to avoid rash and save students' time.	The College has been able to obtain govt. sanction of 2 Office Assistants, 1 Laboratory Assistant and 4 Laboratory Bearers that will meet up the manpower requirements.
More course related text and reference books required.	The Principal and the GB of the college have been intimated to take necessary steps.
More emphasis should be laid on mental well being of students through organizing awareness on mental health and Yoga practice.	A Certificate Course on Yoga introduced for mental and physical well being of the students.
A separate room should be set up for Career Information and Career Guidance.	Proposal submitted to RUSA grants to construct a separate Career Information and Career Guidance Cell in the college campus.
Solar energy should be used as an alternative source of energy in the college.	Solar Street Lights installed in the College Gate as well as in the internal pathway of the campus.
Effective measures should be taken to facilitate students for career guidance, entrepreneurship development and coaching for entry into services.	The College signed MOUs with Gyanam ITI, Taxashila Schools of Civil Services, ICT Academy and Gratia Technology for collaborative works to support students for proving career guidance and entry into services.

MORIDHAL COLLEGE ACADEMIC SESSION 2021-2022

STRENGTHS, WEAKNESSES OF THE COLLEGE AS PERCEIVED BY STUDENTS AND FOLLOW-UP ACTION

1. Teachers are friendly, sympathetic, affectionate and inspiring and they provide guidance for success in future life.
2. Availability of required teaching-learning materials.
3. Adequate number of books in the Library.
4. College has a beautiful clean and green campus.
5. Adequate number of classrooms and laboratories.
6. Classes are held regularly and are sufficient to complete the courses.
7. Well management of Library.
8. The college provides varied facilities for all round development of students.
9. The college pays importance on games & sports and provides adequate facilities for the same.
10. The college is rich in cultural aspect.
11. Congenial hostel facilities.
12. The college maintains a good discipline within the campus.

Weaknesses of the College as perceived by Students	Follow-up Actions taken on Students' Feedback
1. Computer facilities are not adequate as per number of students.	There are 92 computers out of which 50 are used for academic purpose. It is decided to provide some more computers for students' use.
2. Under the guidance and counseling, job oriented training programmes conducted by the college are insufficient.	Guidance and Counselling Cell of the college is intimated to organize more job oriented and skill oriented training programmes during the session.
3. Some text books are not available as per requirement in the Library.	The Librarian of the college is informed to take necessary steps for purchase required books to meet up students needs.
4. Sometime students suffer in hot weather during class.	The two power generators installed at separate places will be re-arranged at one convenient place so as to provide power supply to all the classrooms during load shedding.
5. Drinking water facility in front of all classrooms is not available.	The college is planning to provide running drinking water from a centre point
6. Prohibition of mobile phone and keeping silence in reading room of the Library is not strictly maintained.	The Librarian is informed to keep vigil to prevent use of mobile and breach of silence in the reading room through CC camera monitoring and physical visit.
7. Pursuing MA/MSc in regular mode is not available.	Post Graduate programme in Assamese is approved by Dibrugarh University and will be started from Academic Session 2022-2023.
8. The college has not been able to stop completely paan spitting in nooks and corners.	For prevention of paan spitting, a few additional CC TV cameras installed, Student Union Body informed to look after, awareness created among the students and already tarnished places will be painted.
9. NCC has not been yet introduced in the college.	The college adopted a resolution in the Staff Meeting held on 21-05-2022 to take necessary steps for introduction of NCC.

10. Toilets of new Science Buildings are not flushed and cleaned regularly.	One more person has been employed in addition to two employees for regular cleaning of classrooms, office, toilets and the campus.
11. The college has not taken stringent actions for banning sale of tobacco in petty stalls outside the college campus.	The college authority has served a notice to the few stalls outside the college campus for banning the sale of tobacco.
12. Permanent instructors for regular training in arts, literary & cultural aspects, and games & sports are not available.	Since no Physical Instructor and/or Art & Music Teacher appointed by government in colleges, the college has made arrangement on its own to provide training in the co-curricular aspect with the help of District Sports Office and/or local Artists.
13. The college play ground is un-usable during rainy season due to water logging.	Earth filling is done in water logging areas of the college play ground to make it usable throughout the year.
14. Existing digital classrooms of the college are not adequate.	Decided to make one classroom ICT enabled at the ground floor of the new building.

Laboratory of the department of Physics needs to be renovated	Renovation of the Laboratory of Physics department is going on
More ICT enabled common classrooms required	Proposed to make two more classrooms ICT enabled for common use
The college authority should take necessary measures for Govt. Provincialisation of Science Stream	At constant effort of the college, the Science Stream hitherto run on self finance, was taken over by the Govt. of Assam vide its notification No.PC/HE/Misc.117/2018/167, dated 15 th October 2022
The Library should procure more books to fulfill the requirement of the students under CBCS curriculum	Proposed to procure more books as per the CBCS curriculum for various semester classes
The college authority should take steps to provide financial assistance to each department for research activities	The college proposed to provide financial assistance to departments for conduct of research activities
The college authority should provide financial assistance for the conduct of departmental Parent-Teacher meet and Alumni Meet	The college conceded to provide financial assistance to each department for organizing departmental parent-teacher meet and alumni meet.
The college should focus on involving more students in community related activities to sensitize them with the issues of the local society	The college proposed to involve more students in community works initiating academic adoption of village and school.
