- Dialects of Assamese language (B.A. 6th Semester)

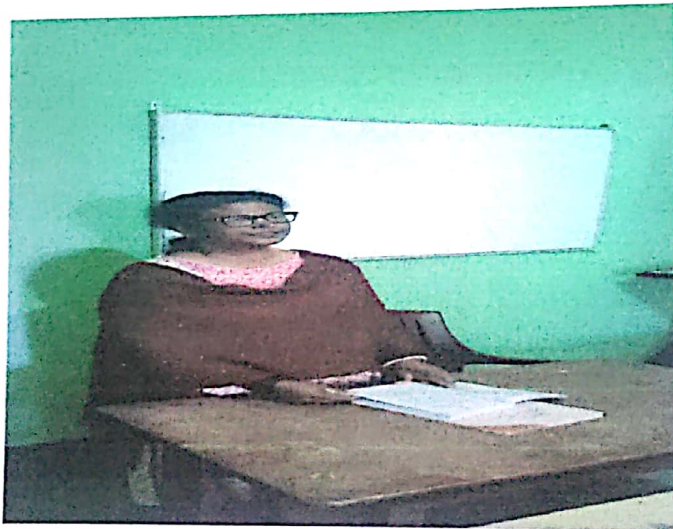
