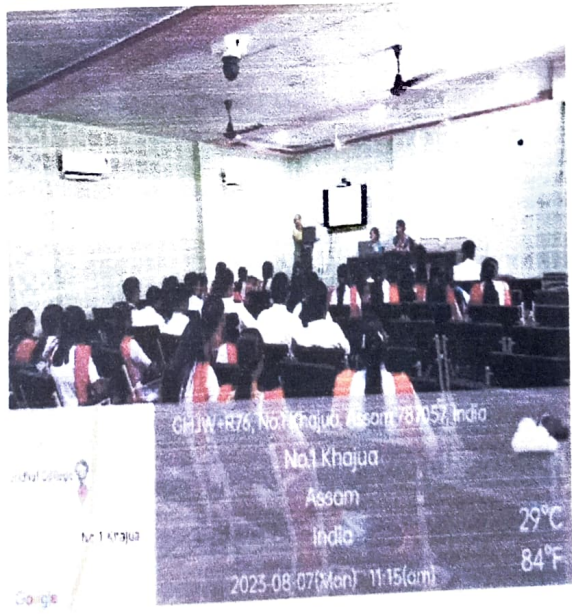
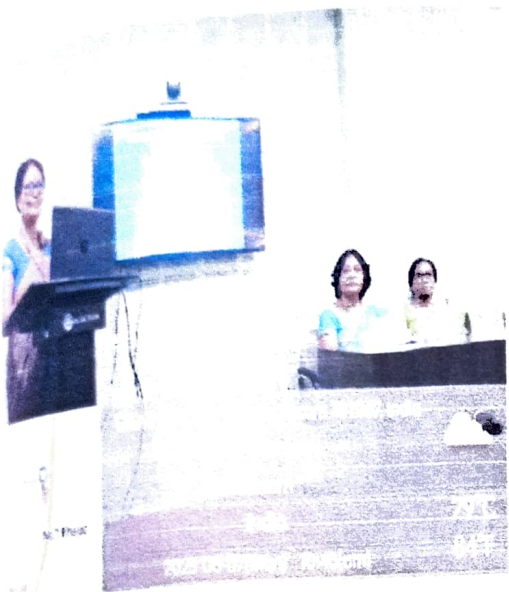

In her deliberation Dr. Saharia highlighted the course structure of FYUGP implemented in the current session briefly. Dr Saharia explained about some attributes be acquired by the students of Philosophy after the end of the Programme e.g Critical thinking, Logical reasoning and Problem Solving ability. Dr. Saharia also explained to the 1<sup>st</sup> semester students of Major Course that the students will be able to acquire Philosophica concept from Indian and Western Perspective, able to differentiate Philosophy from science as well as to identify the similarities between Philosophy and other natural sciences and to deal with the real life situation.

Dr. Junalee Gogoi, Associate Professor , Department of Philosophy has taken class on B.A 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester (Honours) and explained the course outcomes of the allotted papers. Dr. Gogoi explained that the student can develop sense of systematic and critical understanding of Modern Western Philosophy, they can also know the basic concept of both Indian and Western ethics.
