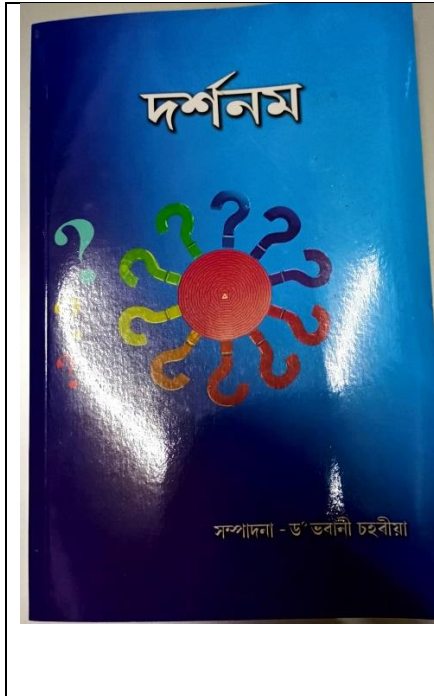
Nature Reflection in Tagore's Santiniketan and Sriniketan
